Arthur is a capital hand.

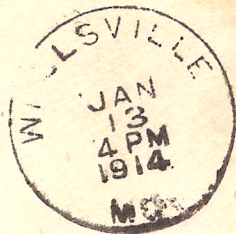
It has been beautiful moonlight
